**Dear friends and families,**

We encourage our residents, staff and families of our community to become vaccinated against COVID-19. And remember, even after vaccination, please continue to maintain physical distancing, use caution when attending gatherings, wear a mask and practice hand hygiene. We remain focused on principles of cleanliness set forth by Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

We are participating with CVS Vaccine Partnership Program. Our pharmacy partner is providing onsite vaccination clinics for our staff and residents. The Pfizer vaccine includes a series of two injections, scheduled 21 days apart. Our next clinic is scheduled for 12/24/2021.

Our current visitation protocols will remain in place until there are new recommendation and guidance provided by the CDC, Department of Health (DOH) and Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
