Currently some of our tests remain held up in Memphis. We are awaiting the delivery and results. We will update you with any positive results.

Family members and all others impacted by the virus will be contacted and provided with results/updates.

We appreciate all of our staff and their hard work in these unprecedented times as well as their commitment to defeating this pandemic. We are proud of the care we provide to our residents.
